 - Bank Statement as of 22 April £4,711.41, currently about £3200 in account.
- **Summer Production** (17 19 July)
 - <u>License Fees</u> £50/performance = £600, however, the reduced cost of renting rehearsal rooms should also be considered as it will help to balance this high fee.
 - <u>Director/Producer Report</u> Coming along quite well. The pairs are getting on with it which is helpful. There is a rehearsal next Thursday – the first time since the read through for everyone to get together.
 - <u>Stage Management/Lighting Update</u> EW spoke to both Mel and Pete they are on board and require specifications. **Action JR** invite to rehearsal and take for a pint after to discuss. EW confirmed that Comm Hall does have a PPL (music license).
 - Prop: Jane needs a Sony Walkman (doesn't have to work) as a prop. Action all to ask around.
 - <u>Poster</u> JR has supplied Jane with details, **Action SH** to check in and find out status as well as
 complete last meeting action for discussing options for including Prima deal on poster.
 - <u>Banner</u> Ring Road, JM usually organizes. Who is the advertising company? **Action JR** to check with JM to get this ordered.

Production Sponsorship: £250

Sponsorship of a Drama Club production includes:

- 1. "This production sponsored by *company name"* on all pre-show advertising materials
- 2. "This production sponsored by *company name*" on front page of production programme
- 3. "This production sponsored by company name" on production page of the website
- 4. Link to sponsoring company from the production page of the website
- 5. Sponsoring company mentions in all social media pre and post performance
- 6. Six complementary tickets to any night of the performance
 - Objective is to have £500 sponsorship per production.
 - Limits to ad content: 50% ad content max for any programme. (A typical programme is
 10 pages/20 sides available.)
 - Decision to charge the standard £1 fee for a programme will be made closer to the date,
 depending on ads sold.
 - Acceptance proposed for ad pricing schedule and the limitation of 50% proposed GM,
 seconded JC, all agreed.
- JC shared idea of doing grant applications as a possible source of support for the club. She will
 look into it following training which she begins next week Action JC
